**Information, Guidelines, Rules and Code of Conduct**

Please initial each Rule to indicate that you have read them.

- \_\_\_ 1. Vendors must supply their own shade, canopy, tables and chairs. It will get dark before event ends, so please bring safe and proper lighting. No open flames allowed.
- \_\_\_ 2. Vendors, Spiritual Readers and Healers must have a copy of Business/Resales License and/or Ministers Credentials on hand. In a shared booth situation, both parties will have to have their individual licenses available. You are solely responsible for collecting and reporting all sales and income taxes for yourself and/ or your business. Food Vendors must also have proper health permits.
- \_\_\_ 3. Fire extinguisher: All Booths must have a Full & Working Fire Extinguisher in the booth.
- \_\_\_ 4. All participants will conduct themselves in a well-behaved and lawful manner at all times.
- \_\_\_ 5. Participants are responsible for all members of their party.
- \_\_\_ 6. The set-up starts Friday at 2 pm and Saturday at 7 am. All Vehicles need to be off the festival grounds by 9 am.
- \_\_\_ 7. Overnight camping is allowed for staff, vendors and vendor's staff only. Tents must be taken down by 9 am both Saturday and Sunday.
- \_\_\_ 8. Per VFW rules, no pets allowed.
- \_\_\_ 9. All booths must be set-up by 9:30 am Saturday ready for festival opening.
- \_\_\_ 10. All booths must stay opened through the whole festival both days and no vehicles will be allowed on property until 6:00 pm Sunday. Early tear down, without the ok of festival coordinator, will revoke the return of your cleaning deposit.
- \_\_\_ 11. The cleaning deposit will be required by all vendors when signing in and will be returned after coordinator has inspected grounds.
- \_\_\_ 12. Limited RV space is available. Please contact the coordinator prior to see if available.
- \_\_\_ 13. Information Booths: These are for non-profit organizations, religious organizations, or others of this sort. No items or services may be sold in these booths, no exceptions.
- \_\_\_ 14. Shared Booth Space: Vendors may share booths with the appropriate approval provided by the event coordinator prior to the event. All participants that will be sharing a space must be listed on the application, read and acknowledge the information, guidelines, rules, and code of conduct and sign the proper forms.
- \_\_\_ 15. Dress: Clothing required at this event.
- \_\_\_ 16. **No swords, daggers, ritual blades allowed** unless sheathed and peace tied. (Vendors may safely display blades and athemes to be used during ritual with prior approval.)
- \_\_\_ 17. **No firearms or weapons allowed.**

- \_\_\_18. No liquor is allowed on the premises of the VFW property or festival area from outside the VFW. There is a full service bar inside the VFW.
- \_\_\_19. No illegal drugs or substances allowed. Those used for medical reasons are required to do so off the grounds.
- \_\_\_20. No sexually explicit, adult only merchandise may be displayed in open areas. If you have these items, they must be kept covered, and totally out of view of children when being shown.
- \_\_\_21. Vendors are responsible to keep their booth area clean and trash put in proper receptacles.
- \_\_\_22. Children under 12 must be attended by a responsible adult at all times.
- \_\_\_23. No open flames are allowed in the vendor booths. Candles for sacred ritual purposes of in performance must be enclosed and kept where they may not come in contact with any clothing or other flammable material. A fire extinguisher must be within reach of any candle or flame during ritual or performance.
- \_\_\_24. No Soliciting without permission of the festival administration.
- \_\_\_25. Additional information, guidelines, rules and code of conducts may be added as necessary. If there is an update, all parties will receive a new copy and notification.

All Participants are vendors, groups, organizations, presenters, entertainers, spiritual readers, consultants, healers, festival staff and volunteers. Rules will be enforced and all participants are expected to do also.
